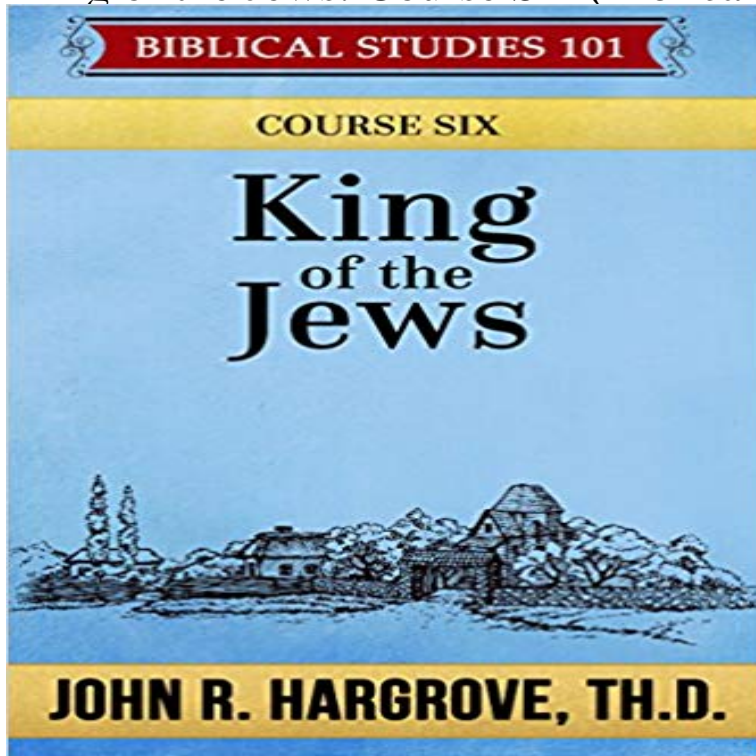


King of the Jews: Course Six (Biblical Studies 101)
