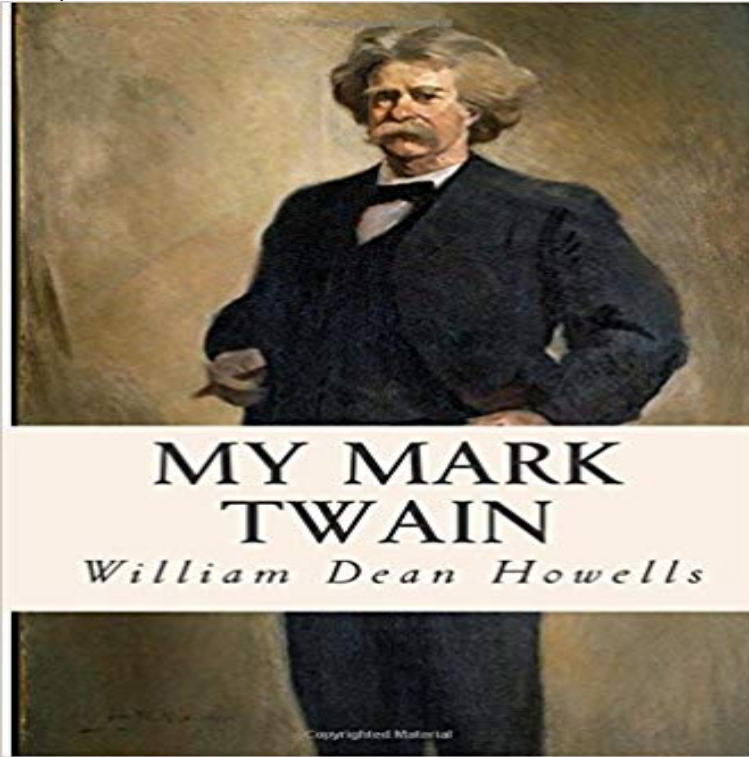


My Mark Twain
